

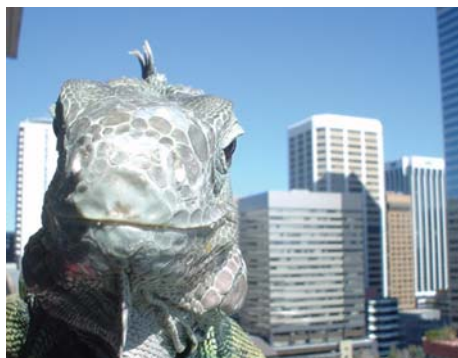
The one stop shop for Spires Shopping Centre

The Problem:
