

A tidy score for West Ham United FC

The Problem:

Like many football grounds, cleaning up after 35,000 fans is a challenge in itself. The sheer volume of waste generated, predominantly that of food, was causing a real health and hygiene problem, one that the newly refurbished Boleyn Ground Stadium could ill afford. The scale of the cleaning operation was also hampered by the lack of a suitable waste compaction solution which would greatly help to alleviate the litter problem around the ground, nearby hotel and conference facilities alike.
